Our beloved sanctuary, a place of worship and fellowship for spiritual growth, needs to be refurbished for both our safety and comfort. This project is years past due and we are moving forward with it and invite you to be a part of a historic moment in the history of Israel Baptist Church through your generous support.

OUR VISION: A sacred space that inspires worship and fosters a deeper connection with God.

OUR GOAL: Raise \$350,000 to replace worn pews and carpeting throughout the sanctuary.

IMPACT: Your generous contributions will help enhance the beauty and comfort of our worship space and create a more welcoming and safer environment for all.

PROJECT TIMELINE: We anticipate the installation of new and comfortable benches and carpeting around mid-April 2025.



- 75 to 100 people received warm clothing through our Winter Clothing Drive. Coats, hats, gloves, scarves, blankets, throws, socks, and children clothes were distributed. While some clean and gently used coats were donated, the majority of winter items were newly purchased thanks to generous monetary donations from IBC members and ministries. In addition, a generous clothing donation valued at \$1,500 was given to IBC by Boscov's Department Store of Camp Hill, PA, where Minister Clarence Banks (brother of Sister Glenece Atwater) is the store manager.
- 44 turkeys were distributed along with canned vegetables. Thanks very much to Union Market for donating 24 turkeys, and thanks to Rev. Roderick Moore who donated 20 turkeys through an organization with whom he is affiliated.
